	Section 1:	No person being the owner or having charge of ducks, chickens or other fowl or animals of any kind, nature or species shall permit them to run at large upon a public place or upon any unenclosed lands or upon the premises of another.	
	Section 2:	No person being the owner or having charge of any dog, whether wearing a registration tag or not, shall permit it to run at large upon a public place or upon the premises of another.	
		No person being the owner or having charge of any cat, whether required to be registered or not, shall permit it to run at large upon a public place or upon the premises of another.	
		No owner, keeper or harborer of any dog shall permit said dog to go beyond the premises of such owner or keeper at any time, unless such dog is properly in leash. The owner or keeper of every dog or cat shall at all times keep such dog or cat either confined upon the premises of the owner or keeper or under reasonable control of some person.	
	Section 3:	The running at large of any such fowl, animal, dog or cat in or upon any of the places mentioned in this section is prima-facie evidence that it is running at large in violation of this section.	
	Section 4:	Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.	
	Section 6:	This Ordinance shall take effect upon the earliest time as permitted by law.

## AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PLAYING OF RADIOS AND OTHER SOUND DEVICES

## \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tiltonsville, County of Jefferson, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: No person shall play any radio, music player such as a "boom box", tape cassette, disc player or television, audio system or musical instrument or any other type of sound service upon any public road, street, highway or private property in this Municipality in a manner or a volume as to disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of other persons. An exception is made for organized events which have received a valid permit from the City under Section 311.02 of the Traffic Code or any other applicable section.

Section 2: No person shall play any radio, music player such as a "boom box", tape cassette, disc player, television, audio system or musical instrument or any other type of sound device in a manner or at a volume which is plainly audible to persons other than those who are in the dwelling unit in which such device or instrument is played and who are voluntarily listeners thereto.

Section 3: Whoever violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree and the sound device used during the commission of the offense shall be subject to seizure.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, necessary for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the citizens of Tiltonsville, Ohio, for the further reasons as set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance and as a result thereof, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; other wise, it shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.
