ORDINANCE NO. 96-1601

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOITERING BY MINORS

* * * * *

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Tiltonsville, County of Jefferson, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: No minor shall loiter in or about any business or public place between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day, except that on Fridays and Saturdays hours shall be from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. of the following day.

Section 2: No minor shall drive or ride aimlessly in a motor vehicle, motorcycle or bicycle between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day, except that on Fridays and Saturdays the hours shall be from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. of the following day.

Section 3: The provisions of this section shall not apply to a minor proceeding home, a minor on an errand directed or approved by a parent, or a minor engaged in gainful and lawful employment.

Section 4: As used in the section, the following definitions shall apply:
(a) "Minor" means any person under the age of eighteen years.
(b) "Business" means any privately owned or operated retail establishment including service stations, restaurants and places of a similar nature and any place of amusement or entertainment to which the public or certain members thereof are invited.
(c) "Operator" means any individual, firm association, partnership or corporation operating, managing or conducting any business and as applied to associations or partnerships, includes the members or partners thereof, and as applied to corporations, includes the officers thereof.
(d) "Parent" includes any natural parent, guardian or any adult person over twenty-one years of age responsible for the care and custody of a minor.
(e) "Public place" means any public street, highway, road, alley, park, playground, public building, vacant lot or privately owned property permitted to be used by the public or certain members thereof.
(f) "Loiter" means to idle, loaf, linger or to wander or to stroll aimlessly.
(g) "Drive" or "ride aimlessly" means to

drive or ride in a motor vehicle, motorcycle or bicycle in a circuitous route or to joy ride.

Section 4: No parent shall knowingly permit any minor in his charge to loiter in or at any business or public place or to drive or ride aimlessly between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following day, except that on Fridays and Saturdays the hours shall be 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. of the following day.

Section 5: Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Any minor violating Sections 1 Or 2 hereof shall be dealt with in accordance with Juvenile Court Law and Procedure.

Section 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance, necessary for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the citizens of Tiltonsville, Ohio, for the further reasons as et forth in the preamble of this Ordinance and as a result thereof, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force upon the earliest time allowed by law.
