ORDINANCE NO.: 017-2007

ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF DOG FECES
UPON PUBLIC PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Tiltonsville is protected by the requirements of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Tiltonsville, County of Jefferson, State of Ohio, in session duly assembled:

SECTION I: Any person owning, having an interest in, harboring or having charge of the care, custody, control or possession of any dog which defecates upon public property, including, but not limited to streets, walkways and parks within the Village must immediately remove and legally dispose of the feces. Failure to so remove and dispose of the feces shall constitute an infraction. Nothing herein shall be deemed to authorize any person to enter upon or to dispose of dog feces on the private property of another without consent or proper authority.

SECTION II: Any person committing an infraction of this ordinance will be issued a civil citation and subject to the following fines:

First Infraction: \$25.00
Second Infraction: \$50.00
Third and all Further Infractions: \$100.00

SECTION III: All citations shall be issued personally or by regular U.S. Mail. Any and all appeals of citations shall be made in writing to the Village Administrator, within 30 days of receipt of citation. All fines assessed shall be paid within 30 days after receipt of citation or upon denial of appeal.

SECTION IV: Such citation may be used independently or in conjunction with any other enforcement method.
