

Guidelines for Village of Tiltonsville Tag Days Held at Farm Lane and Ohio Street

- ❖ No children are permitted to participate in tag days. Teenagers are permitted to tag, but must be supervised by an adult.
- ❖ No one is to run or step out into the street as to block or impede traffic.
- ❖ Each group must have orange cones, which you can obtain from the village police department, and a sign designating what organization they are collecting for. The sign must be displayed so that motorists can view it clearly. The sign can be no smaller than 8 ½ by 11 inches and you must return the cones to the police department following the event.
- ❖ Each group must stay within the designated areas while tagging. **No person is allowed to stand in the middle of the intersection or roadway.**
 - The designated areas are:
 - On the western side of the intersection, taggers must stand along the side of the street next to the old skating rink.
 - On the eastern side of the intersection, taggers must stand along the side of the street next to the Village sign.

Officers on duty will check the area periodically and if it is determined that the organization is violating any of the rules, the officer will stop the group and ask them to leave.

I have read and understand the guidelines above. I understand that I must follow these rules, and failure to follow the rules will result in termination of my organization's tag day.
