RESOLUTION #011-2010

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR VILLAGE OF TILTONSVILLE TAG DAYS HELD AT FARM LANE AND OHIO STREET AND CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ADHERING TO GUIDELINES

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Tiltonsville, that guidelines for tag days held at the intersection of Farm Lane and Ohio Street are necessary for the safety of the participants:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TILTONSVILLE, COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: No children are permitted to participate in tag days. Teenagers are permitted to tag, but must be supervised by an adult.

SECTION 2: No one is to run or step out into the street as to block or impede traffic.

SECTION 3: Each group must have orange cones, which can be obtained from the Village police department, and a sign designating what organization they are collecting for. The sign must be displayed so that motorists can view it clearly. The sign can be no smaller than 8 ½ by 14 inches. Cones must be returned to the police department following the event.

SECTION 4: Each group must stay within the designated areas while tagging. No person is allowed to stand in the middle of the intersection or roadway. The designated areas are:

- On the western side of the intersection, taggers must stand along the side of the street next to the old skating rink.
- On the eastern side of the intersection, taggers must stand along the side of the street next to the Village welcome sign.

SECTION 5: Officers on duty will check the area periodically and if determined that the organization is violating any of the rules, the officer will stop the group and ask them to leave.

SECTION 6: A representative of the group must sign a document stating that they have read and understand the guidelines as stated, and that failure to follow the rules will result in termination of the tag day.

SECTION 7: The provisions of this chapter shall not be deemed to be a limitation or restriction on the authority of any department, division, official, or enployee of the Village, but shall be deemed as supplemental to any authority existing by virtue of the statutes of the State, or any ordinance heretofore enacted by Village council.
